During her Northeastern co-op rotations, Lim worked as a law clerk in many different legal positions--at the Office of the Attorney General, for the Honorable William G. Young, U.S.D.C. for the District of Massachusetts, at Bingham Dana and finally at Kotin, Crabtree & Strong.
