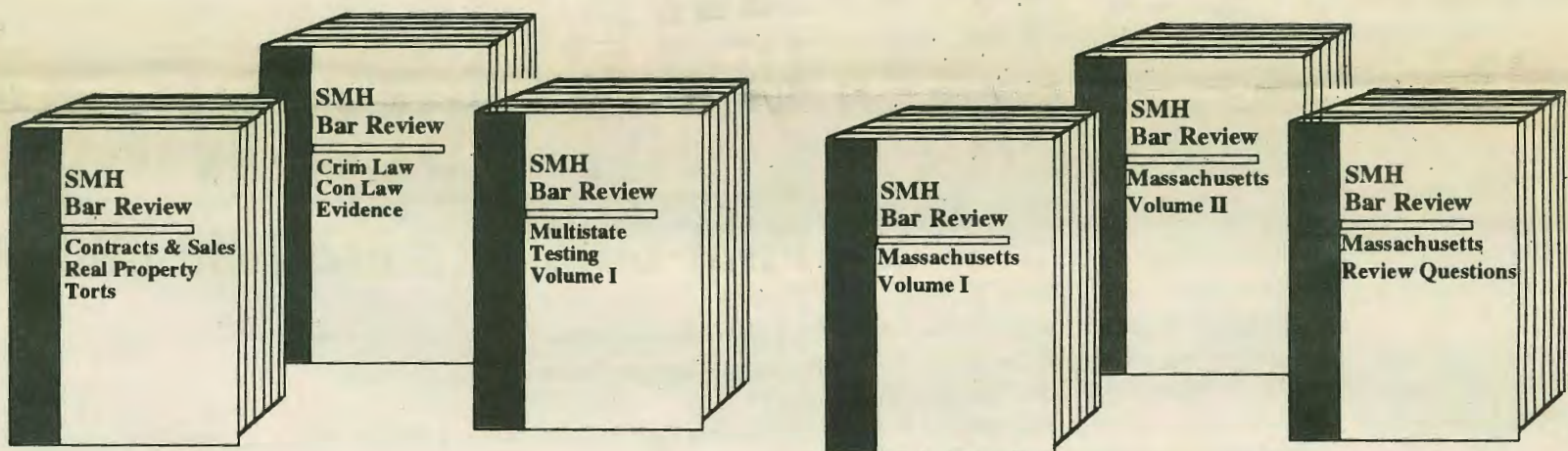
"I'm playing Bankruptcy roulette," he whined. "Yesterday, Hillinger called on a kid named Boogersfielck. She's bound to get to me soon!"

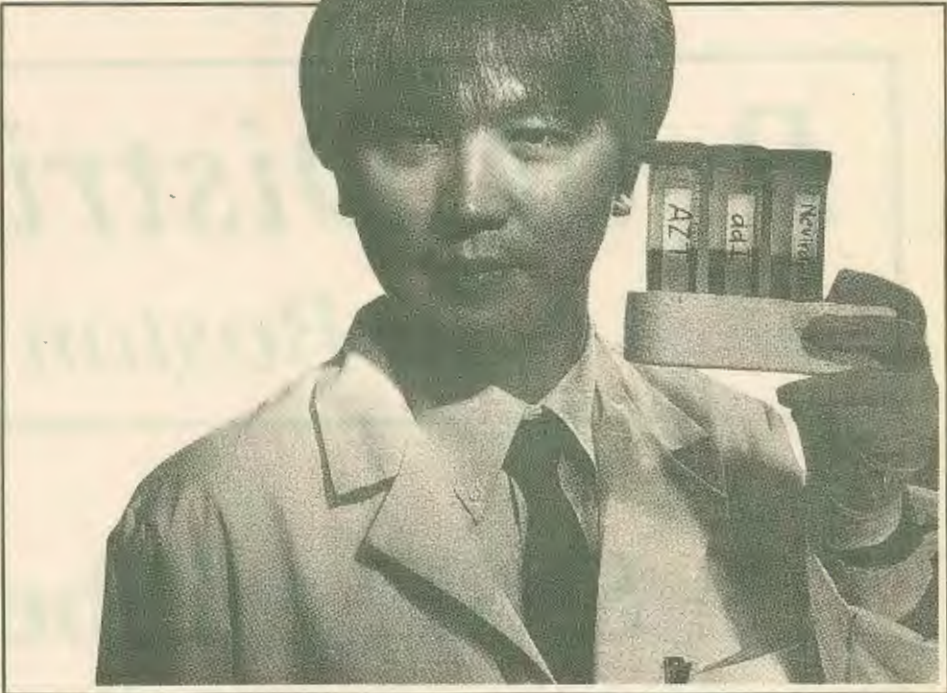
By late Monday, Dean-Dean had revived the U.S. economy, reduced infla-

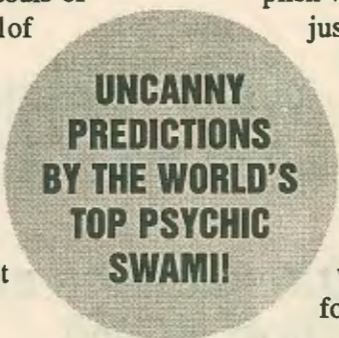
